DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 13, 1953 at 4:00 A. M. 24 hours had elapsed since running 285' of new 8-5/8" casing landed at 298' and cemented with 150 sacks neat cement, circulated to surface.

Casing shut off was tested with 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling shoe. Since there was no appreciable drop in pressure, drilling operations were resumed.
