DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 9 joints 276.84' of 13-3/8" OD 8 RT 48# H-40 SS casing. Set and cemented at 295.84' w/325 sacks Lone Star Neat Cement. Plug at 280'. Maximum pressure 150#. Circulated 20 sacks of cement.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 13-3/8" casing w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 280' to 295'. Tested cement below casing shoe w/400# for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
