DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 8 joints 260.56' of 13-3/8" OD 8 RT 48# SS casing. Set and cemented at 279' w/325 sacks Trinity Neat Regular cement. Plug at 264'. Maximum pressure 300#. Circulated approximately 25 sacks cement.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 13-3/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 264' to 279'. Tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
