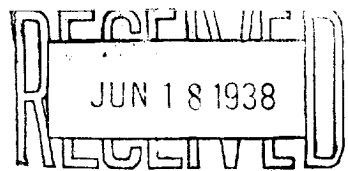

T. D. 3497 Line. Palled rods, acidized with 380 gallons Dowell "IX" and reran rods. June 8th well pumped 10 hours, recovering 25 bbls. oil load, acid & fresh oil with no gauges on water. June 9th pumped 22 bbls. oil, 55 bbls. water in 16 hours. Down 8 hours with broken water pump on Waukesha engine. June 10th pumped 10 bbls. oil, 23 bbls. water in 14 hours. Down 10 hours repairing water pump on Waukesha Engine. June 16th pumped 13 bbls. oil, 99 bbls. water in 24 hours.
