### DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Moved in and rigged up rotary tools. Spudded well at 8:30 AM 11/16/63. Drilled 8-3/4" hole to 961'. Had reamed 8-3/4" hole to 13-3/4" to 775' when Kelly twisted off and drill pipe became stuck. Six days of fishing operations failed to recover all of drill collars. Left two 7" OD and two 8" OD drill collars in hole from 693-775'. Spotted the following neat cement plugs to P & A: 25 sax from 155' to 180'; 25 sax from 75' to 100' and 10 sax in top of hole. Left 10#/gal gel mud between plugs. Job complete at 4:00 AM 11/25/63. Skidded rig 25' north for Justis #3-X well for replacement to this well.
