DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We propose to drill a well with rotary tools to an approximate T. D. of 120' to test the producing capabilities of the Miocene and Tertiary formations. 950' of 9-5/8" 35 lb m-40 surface casing will be set and cemented to surface. If the well proves productive, 5-1/2" 15.5 lb casing will be set as oil string and a single Miocene completion attempted. Cement on the 5-1/2" casing will be returned to the base of the salt section.

This is a replacement well for the Justis #3 Well, 330' PSL, 990' FEL, Sec. 11, T-25-S, R-37-E, which was abandoned due to junk in hole. Verbal approval for this well was received from Mr. Brown on 11/22/63.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
