Gentlemen:

Union Texas Petroleum Corporation has recently completed its Langlie "B" No. 1 well, located 330 feet from South line and 2310 feet from West line of Section 14, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, in the Justis Blinbry Field.

We respectfully request an Administrative Approval for Off-Lease Storage, Rule 309-C, to apply to the Blinbry zone of the subject lease. We propose to utilize an existing separate tank battery located on our Langlie "B" Lease in the same section, as shown on the attached plat.

Since separate facilities are available, commingling of the Blinbry production from the two leases will not result, nor will inter-communication exist. The Langlie "B" Lease is owned by Union Texas Petroleum Corporation 83.333% and Joseph Seagram & Sons 16.667%. This being Federal land, the Lease Number is NM-01995. The Langlie "B" Lease, location of off-lease storage, has the identical ownership and has a Federal Lease Number of NM-05698.

By separate correspondence, we are requesting both Joseph Seagram & Sons, and the Regional Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey for their consent to the proposed off-lease storage. We trust they will so advise you of their consent by separate letter.

Gentlemen:

Union Texas Petroleum Corporation has recently completed its lease "D" No. 1 well, located 330 feet from south line and 1310 feet from west line of Section 14, T-15-S, R-17-E, Las Comas, in the Austin Shiloh Field.

We respectfully request an Administrative Approval for Off-lease Storage, Rule 30-6, to apply to our Shiloh zone of the subject lease. We request no drilling or existing separate tank battery located on our land in the same section, as shown on the attached plat.

Since separate land lease and available, including of the Shiloh production from the two leases will not result, nor will inter-composition exist. The land lease is owned by Union Texas Petroleum Corporation 61.33% and Joseph Seagram & Sons 38.67%. This being Federal land, the lease Number is 14-01047. The lease "D" lease, location of off-lease storage, has an identical ownership and has a Federal Lease Number of 14-01048.

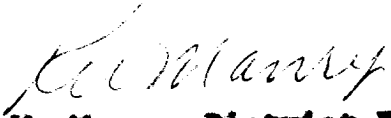
