Gentlemen:

Attached is TEXACO Inc.'s requested revision to Application for Triple Tubingless Completion, dated January 22, 1963, for State of New Mexico "BZ" (NCT-10) Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the south line and 2310 feet from the west line, Unit K, Section 2, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was approved by Order No. MC-1281 for triple tubingless completion in Tubb-Drinkard and Devonian formations adjacent to the North Justis Field and from an undesignated Abo Pool through parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore. During recent completion operations, the Tubb-Drinkard was completed as a flowing oil well and the Abo was found non-productive. The Abo has been squeezed off with cement and completion of the Blinbry is presently being attempted in the former Abo string and the Devonian in the Devonian string.


Order No. MC-1281 approved running parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch casing for each zone. However, in lieu of using 2-3/8 inch casing for each formation, separate strings of 2-7/8 inch casing were run to serve the Abo and Devonian formations and a string of 2-3/8 inch casing was run to serve the Tubb-Drinkard formation.

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In view of the above cited facts, TEXACO Inc. hereby respectfully requests administrative approval under Rule 112-A for the proposed tubingless completion in Blinebry and Devonian formations using 2-7/8 inch casing and the Tubb-Drinkard formation using 2-3/8 inch casing. It is also requested that Order No. MC-1281 be revised to read for authorization to triply complete TEXACO Inc. State of New Mexico "BZ" (NCT-10) Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 2, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Devonian, Blinebry, and Tubb-Drinkard formations adjacent to the North Justis Field, with production from the Devonian and Blinebry formations being through strings of 2-7/8 inch casing and production from the Tubb-Drinkard formation being through 2-3/8 inch casing, all casing being cemented in a common well bore.

Attached is a copy of the plat showing the area immediately surrounding TEXACO's State of New Mexico "BZ" (NCT-10) Lease and a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed tubingless completion.
