Attached is TEXACO's application for tubingless completion for the C. C. Fristoe "B" (NCT-2) Well No. 8, located 1980 feet from the north line and 1979 feet from the east line, Unit G, Section 35, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. TEXACO plans to complete this well as a dual tubingless completion in the Justis (Paddock-Gas) and North Justis (Blinberry-Oil) Pools. It is anticipated that all zones will flow initially. 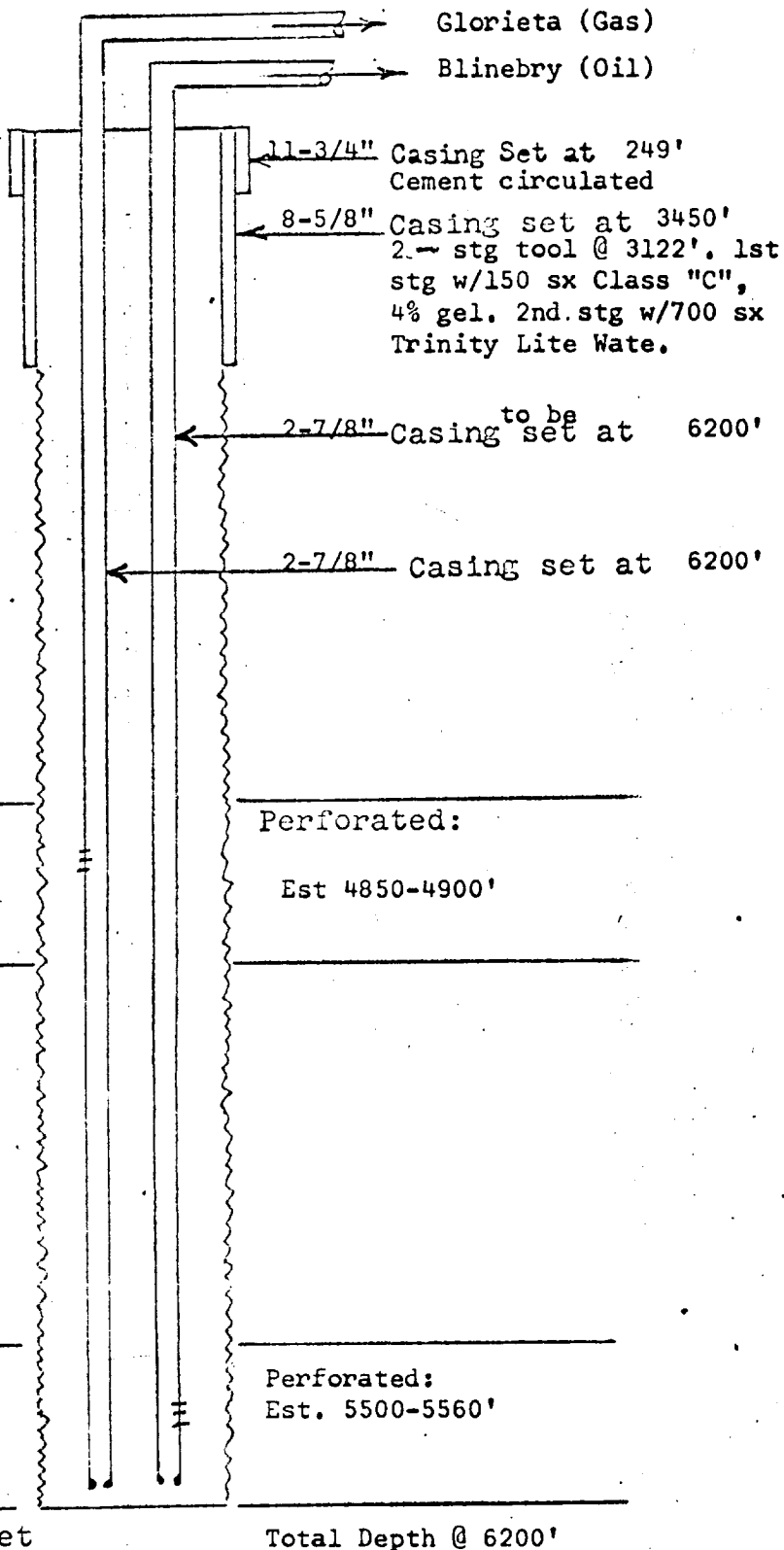

If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.
- NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard perforation unit in either or both of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.

DIAGRAMMATIC SKETCH SHOWING DUAL COMPLETION INSTALLATION (TUBINGLESS)

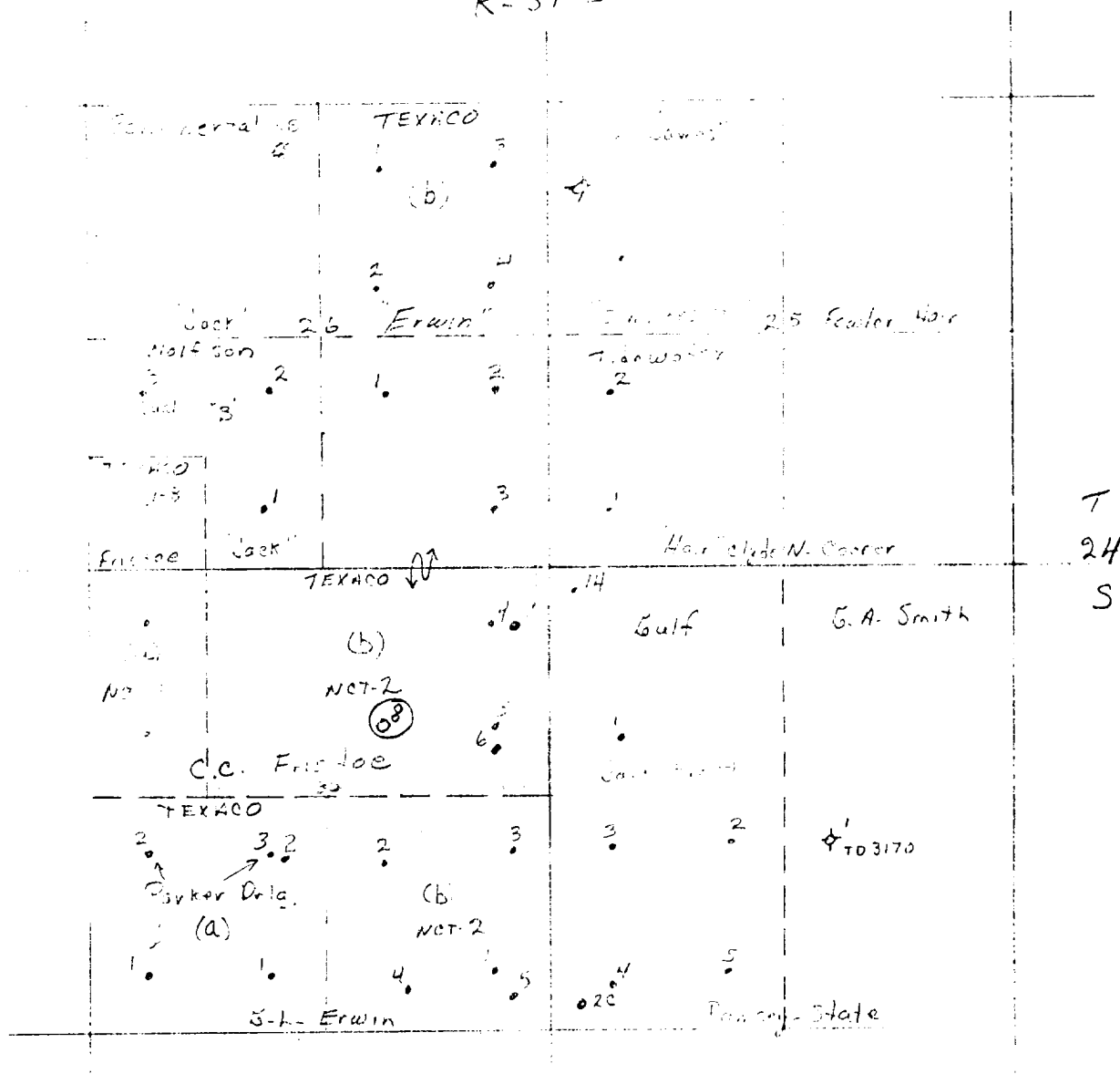
2-7/8" casing to be cemented with 850 sacks Class "C", 4% gel. Cement volume equals 250% of annular space from TD to int. csg.
