ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

We propose to drill a 12,600 foot well to test the Strawn Section of the Pennsylvanian. This test will be drilled with rotary tools.

This test is to be drilled under Communitization Agreement covering the entire Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Authority for this Communitization Agreement is found in New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order Number R-2439 of February 28, 1963 and concerning the West Jal Strawn.

Surface casing, 13 3/8", will be run to an approximate depth of 350 feet and cemented with 400 sacks.

An intermediate string, 9 5/8", will be run to about 5,200 feet and cemented with 2,000 sacks.

At an approximate depth of 11,300 feet, or within 200 feet above the top of the Strawn, a string of 7" casing will be run and cemented with 400 sacks.

If the gas distillate pay found in the Skelly well in Section 20 is productive, a 5" liner will be run to total depth -- the top of the liner will come back into the 7" casing at approximately 11,100 feet. The 5" liner will be cemented with 100 sacks.

All casing run and cemented will be under methods prescribed by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

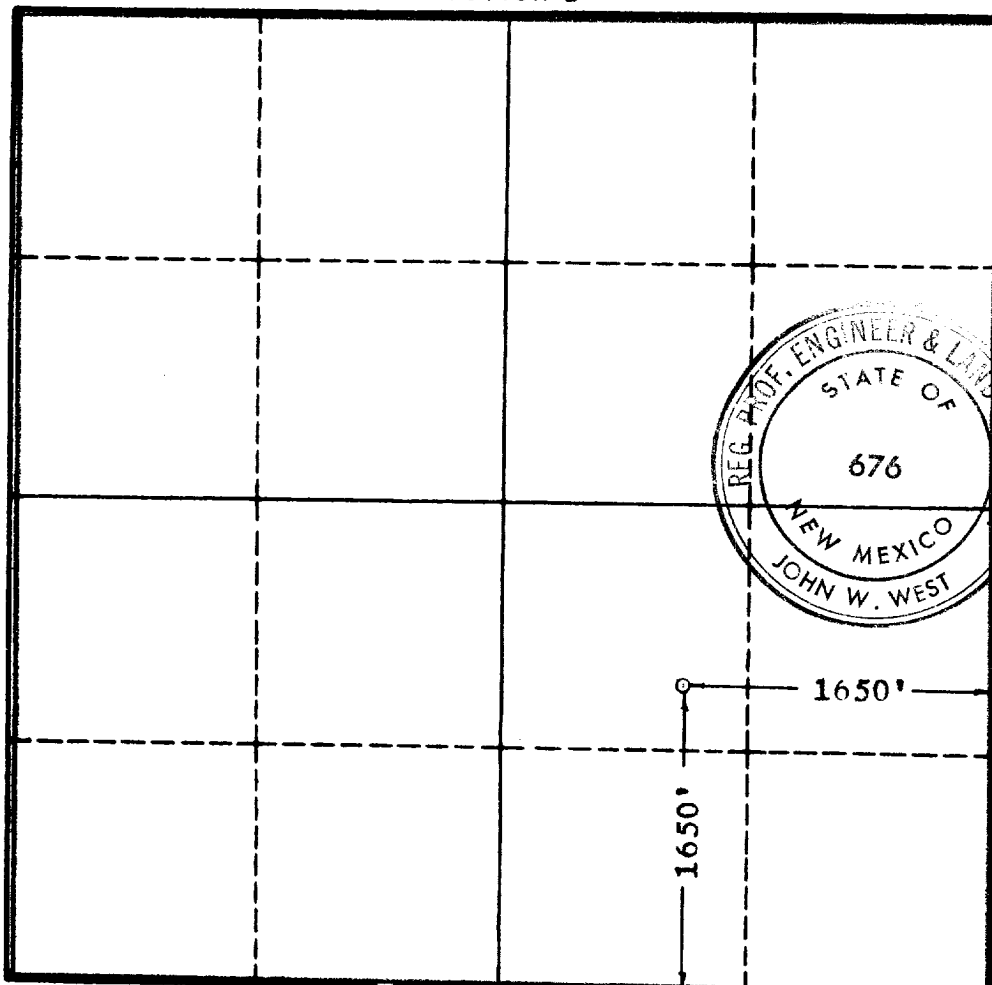
