
Mr. Sexton,

Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. respectfully requests to sell approximately 97 barrels of produced oil from our newly completed Mexico J #9 well. The produced oil currently occupies a rental frac tank on the same sight as the subject well. TEPI would like to transfer this oil to the Mexico J and L Battery where it will be sold to Tex New Mex Pipeline.

The Mexico J #9 was previously producing in the West Dollarhide Drinkard Unit. Texaco then plugged back out of the West Dollarhide Drinkard Unit and recompleted up-hole in the Wildcat San Andres formation. The new completion was largely unsuccessful producing mainly water and continued production would be uneconomical. Consequently TEPI has decided to Plug and Abandon the subject well nullifying the need for a permanent surface commingle order from the commission.
