Reference: Request for Allowable on R.L. Mosley #1 330 FEL & 1650 FSL, Sec. 34, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, Justis Blinebry Production

Gentlemen:

The captioned well was treated down the casing with 30,000 gallons refined oil and  $45,000\frac{3}{7}$  sand. This work was reported on C-103 dated February 9,1966.

The load oil was recovered by flowing through the casing. After the load oil was recovered, the well was produced to allow the formation to clean up prior to killing and running tubing.

The well will be killed today and tubing installed tomorrow. As soon as the tubing is landed, the well will be swabbed off and allowed to clean up.

We would appreciate your approval of an allowable as requested on the attached C-104, so that the purchaser can move the oil which is now in the storage tanks. This will allow storage so that the well can be produced immediately after tubing is landed. This tubing depth will be reported on C-103.

Your kind attention to this will be appreciated.
