4. Set pkr. @ 4700'. Acidize perfs 4768'-4809' w/1500 gals. 7 1/2% HCl acid in 3-stages using 500# rock salt between stages. Flushed w/28 bbls. 2% HCl Water.

5. Install pumping equipment. On 24 Hr. potential test well pumped 30 bbls. oil & 85 BW.
