7.01 APPLICATION TO DOWNHOLE COMMINGLE HUMPHREY QUEEN UNIT (HQU) WELL NO'S 13 & 16, LANGLIE MATTIX QUEEN UNIT (LMQU), WELL NO. 10, LANGLIE MATTIX SEVEN RIVERS QUEEN & JALMAT POOLS LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Dear Sir:

By letter of July 28, 1980 we were advised that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) had reviewed wells in the Langlie Mattix and Jalmat Pools and found approximately 50 wells crossing pool boundaries without authority for such practices.

Three Mobil Producing Texas and New Mexico Inc. (MPTM) operated wells, the Humphrey Queen Unit Well No's 13 & 16, and the Langlie Mattix Queen Unit Well No. 10, were found to be in violation.

The NMOCD called a meeting August 7, 1980, to discuss the problem with the operators and determine the corrective action to be taken on the out of limit wells. Recommended corrective action that should be taken as decided at the meeting is as follows:

- Squeeze off the section of the wells that is outside of the pool limits, or,
- (2) File for a hearing for exception to the field rules for the wells involved, or
- (3) Apply for permission to downhole commingle.
