Attached hereto in duplicate is our application for administrative approval to dually complete as a Jalmat Gas Well and a Langlie Mattix water injection well our Jack "A-29" No. 6, located in Unit G of Section 29, Township 24S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico. Hearing was held on January 6, on our application (Case No. 4486) to inject water into this well. Testimony at the hearing mentioned the possibility of dually completing the well and described in general the manner in which the well would be completed.

If, under the circumstances, this application is eligible for administrative approval, we should appreciate your further handling and approval of it. If administrative approval is not available to the application, we should appreciate your setting the matter for hearing on the February 3, 1971, Examiner Docket.
