Amoco Production Company respectfully requests administrative approval for simultaneous dedication of a 320 acre non-standard proration unit for our South Mattix Unit Well Nos. 36 and 11 located in Units B and H, respectively, Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Fowler Upper Paddock, Lea County, New Mexico.

Order R-2426 dated March 1, 1953, approved a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Fowler Upper Paddock Pool. Our well No. 36 is located in Unit B, 990 feet from the north line and 2310 feet from the east line of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
