The above referenced well was temporarily abandoned because of continuing down hole mechanical problems caused by corrosion. The costs of pulling units and replacing rods and tubing was far beyond the income. It was decided to TA this well and either wait for prices to reach a point where it is feasible to operate, or possibly convert to a salt water disposal.

Lanexco, Inc. request permission to continue the TA'd status by setting a CIBP at 3000 ft., then load the casing and pressure test to 500 PSI for 30 minutes.

This work will be done as soon as possible upon BLM approval.
