I have notified Mr. Clyde Cooper of Jal, New Mexico, owner of the surface land in NE/4 SW/4 Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E, of my intention to drill a 3300 foot Langlie Mattix test 1650 FWL and 2310 FSL of Section 33.
