Dear Mr. Sexton:

Enclosed are the well location and dedication plats (Form C-102) for the affected wells in the above referenced non-standard proration unit as was requested.

The W. H. Harrison D #7 was reclassified from a Jalmat oil well to a Jalmat gas well due to excessive GOR as of September 1, 1984. It has become a part of a multiple well unit consisting of the W/2 of Sec. 29, T24S, R37E, dedicated to the following wells by Amended Administrative Order #NSP-1325 dated Jan. 22, 1985:

W. H. Harrison A #2
W. H. Harrison D #1
W. H. Harrison D #6
W. H. Harrison D #7

The W. H. Harrison D #7 has been producing since September 1, 1984. It has always been metered separately from the other wells on the lease, so the purchaser, El Paso Natural Gas Co., has not made a new connection. We respectfully request that when an allowable is assigned to the W. H. Harrison D #7, it be made retroactive to September 1, 1984.
