

10. Plans for Restoration of the Surface:

- A. After completion of drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for operations will be removed. Pits will be filled and location cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in an aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
- B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
- C. After abandonment of the well, surface restoration will be in accordance with the ~~MLL~~ <sup>surface owner</sup> and accomplished as expeditiously as possible. Surface owner restoration letter attached.

11. Other Information:

- A. Topography: Land surface is gently rolling.
- B. Soil: Soil is a loamy clay containing sand and is underlain with caliche.
- C. Flora & Fauna: The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of Yucca, native grass and sand sage. The wild life is typical of a semi-desert and consists of coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles and quail.
- D. Ponds & Streams: None
- E. Residences and other structures: None
- F. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season. Oil and gas production.
- G. Surface Ownership: Wellsite is on fee surface. Owner is Mr. Clyde N. Cooper, Box 72, Jal, N.M. After abandonment, surface restoration will be in agreement with surface owner.
