
Reference is made to your application dated February 2, 1995 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within both of Texaco's (Reserve) Cooper Jal Langmat and (Reserve) Cooper Jal Jalmat Waterflood Projects, established by Division Order Nos. R-4019 and R-4020, respectively, both orders dated August 25, 1970.

It is our understanding that the proposed Cooper Jal Unit Well No. 413 is to be drilled 1250 feet from the North line and 1300 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Langlie-Mattix and Jalmat (Oil) Pools, Cooper Jal Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

The NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 30 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for both pools.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(1), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
