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This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 104.F, revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, and 111.C (2).


The applicable drilling window or "producing area" within both the Justis-Blinbry and Justis-Tubb-Drinkard Pools for this wellbore shall include that area within the subject 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 NE/4 (Unit G) of Section 35 that is:

- (a) no closer than 330 feet to the north and east boundaries of the unit; and
- (b) no closer than 10 feet to the south and west boundary of this unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the above-described non-standard subsurface oil producing area/bottomhole oil well location is hereby approved.

The operator shall comply with all provisions of Division General Rule 111 applicable in this matter.
