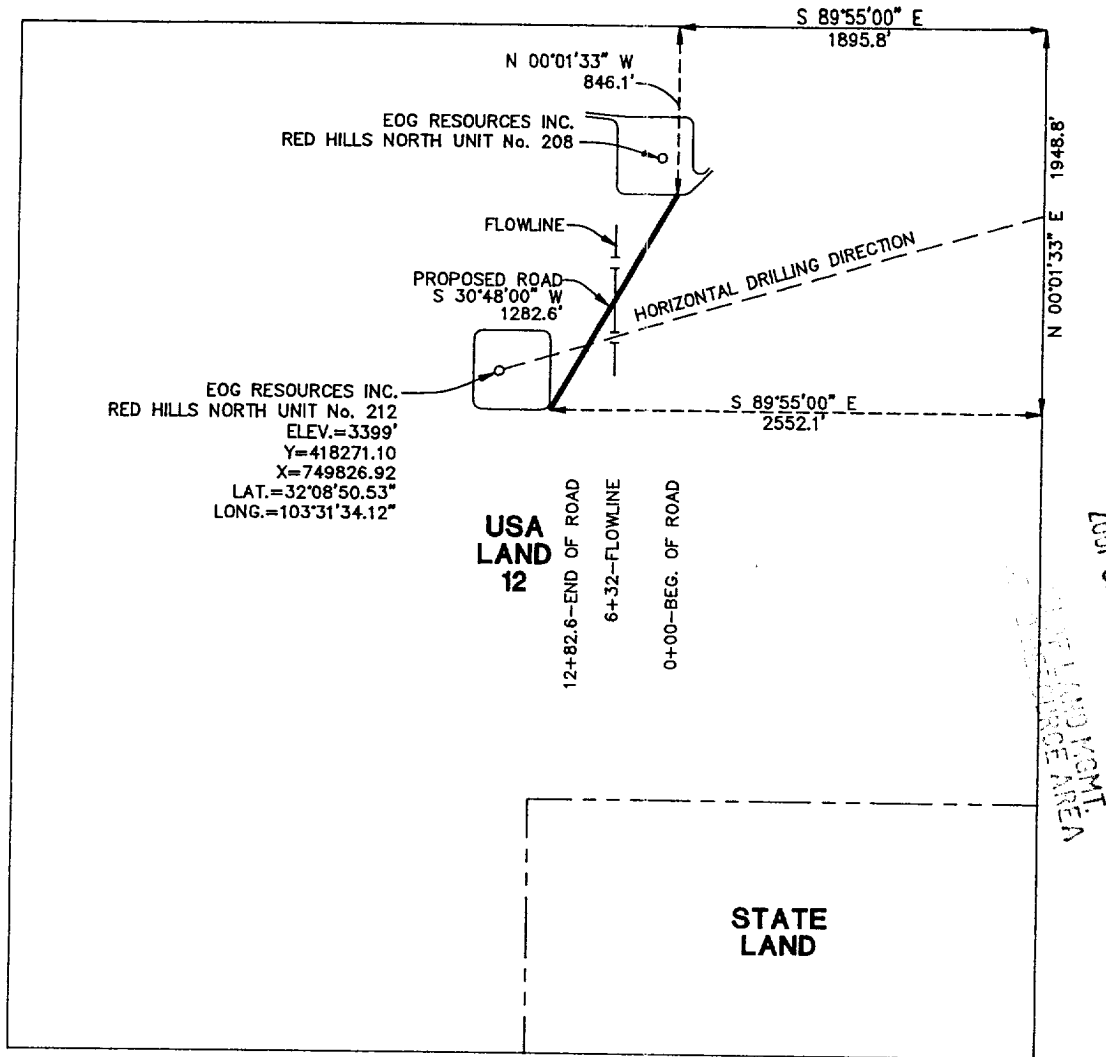

THENCE S 30° 48' 00\" W, with the centerline of proposed road, 1282.6 feet to a point in the southeast corner of a well pad for EOG Resources, Inc. RED HILLS NORTH UNIT No. 212, for the end of this road, from which point the northeast corner of said Section 12 bears S 89° 55' 00\" E, 2552.1 feet and N 00° 01' 33\" E, 1948.8 feet.
