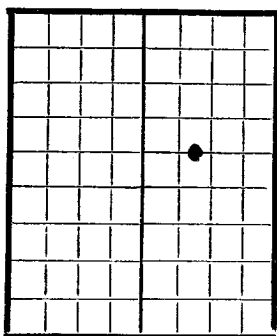

Additional information: \*Oil string will be cemented with 200 sax at shoe and 200 sax through 2-stage tool set at approximately 1200' opposite anhydrite section at top of salt.
