DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5½" casing set at 2991' and cemented by Halliburton August 11, 1949, with 200 sax at shoe and 150 sax through 2-stage tool at 1200'. Upper plug drilled out to below 2-stage tool, tested with 1000# pressure; held for one hour. Drilled balance of upper plug and plug at shoe. Cement job at shoe did not hold 1000#. Squeezed additional 100 sax around shoe, let set 48 hours, drilled plug, tested with 1000# for one hour. Shut-off obtained and drilling resumed.
