Dear Mr. Culbertson:

Recently I wrote you requesting that you file Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Test Casing Shut-Off, on wells which you drill in New Mexico.

Today we received two Form C-102s on the Thomas #1 Well located in the SE/4 of Sec. 24, T. 24S, R. 36E. It seems that you do not understand exactly the purpose of the Form C-102. What we need on this form is to know the date casing is set, the date you plan to test casing shut-off, the size, weight and depth of casing; formation landed in; data on landing or cementing of the string of casing to be tested and quantity of cement used; method of testing; and the total depth of well.

This form should be filed between the time casing is set and casing shut-off tested. Then, within ten days, followed by the Form C-103, Report on Result of Test of Casing Shut-Off.

Enclosed please find the Form C-102s which you filed with us. I am returning these for the above stated information. Thank you for your cooperation with the Commission in the past and if there are any questions concerning what we expect on the forms filed with this office we will be glad to help you.
