FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The objective of this work is to open pay intervals fully and to stimulate these intervals so that production will be increased. The well produced 352 Mcf per day against 100 psig on the latest deliverability test.

Intended procedure: (1) Move in workover rig; (2) Kill well; (3) Pull tubing; (4) Run radioactivity logs; (5) Perforate with 2 shots per foot potential pay zones; (6) Run tubing; (7) Treat pay sections with 10,000 gallons sand-oil; and (8) Swab out oil and place on production.

The well is presently perforated from 2900 to 3200 feet, and has never been stimulated in this zone.
