FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

Production prior to workover - None

The purpose of this workover is to revive production by treating the formation 3035 to 3210 feet with a 6,000 gallon (one pound per gallon) sand-oil squeeze.

Intended Procedure: It is proposed to treat the well according to the following procedure: (1) Move in pump trucks and break down the formation with oil, (2) inject a 12,000 gallon sand-oil mixture, (3) overflush with a minimum of 10 barrels of oil, (4) shut well back into production.
