DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well shot 8/20/50 with 280 qts. glycerine from 3020 to 3160'. Did not unload. Cleaned out to 3075'. Set plastic bridge in brown lime 2960-70. Ran 5" liner from 2660 to 2960', set in Dow plastic and sealed to 7" casing with lead ring seal at top of liner. Let set 10 hours and tested with 1000# pump pressure. No appreciable drop. Let set 24 hours. Drilled plug. Now cleaning out to P.B. total depth of 3170'.
