5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at 3002', cemented 3/29/51 with 200 sax around shoe and 200 sax through 2-stage tool at 1122'. On 4/1/51 drilled upper plug and tested for one hour with 1500# pump pressure, no pressure drop. Drilled lower plug and tested again for one hour with 1500# pressure, no pressure drop. Shut-off obtained and drilling resumed.
