Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of March 28, 1955, regarding the assignment of acreage to your S. W. Harrison Wells No. 1 and No. 3, located in the SW/4 of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Both of the aforesaid wells are presently classified and completed within the Jalmat Gas Pool.

This is to inform you that for the purposes of gas prorationing in the Jalmat Gas Pool, your S. W. Harrison Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, is hereby authorized to operate as a non-standard gas proration unit with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based on the unit size of 120 acres.

Due to the classification of your Harrison Well No. 3, it shall be impossible to operate said well as an oil well and therefore it must be operated and assigned as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool. Therefore, you are hereby authorized to operate the S. W. Harrison Well No. 3, located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.
