Gentlemen:

Humble's S. W. Harrison Well No. 1 produces as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool and has a 160 acre unit assigned to it which is described as follows:

> Township 24 South, Range 36 Bast, Lea County SW/4 of Section 25

Our S. W. Harrison Well No. 3, located in the NB 4 of the SW/4 of Section 25, T-24-S, R-36-E, produces as an oil well and is currently carried on the oil proration schedule in the Cooper Jal Fool. The staire producing section of Well No. 3 is in the Jalmat interval, and since we plan to continue to produce it as an oil well, we are requesting that the acreage for Harrison No. 1 be decreased to 120 acres so that the other 40 wares in the 160 acre tract can be assigned to Well No. 3.

We have attached revised unit plats which show bur assigned acreage to S. W. Harrison No. 1 as the S/2 of the SW/4 and SE/4 of the SW/4, a total of 120 acres, and the acreage assigned to S. W. Harrison No. 5 as the NE/4 of the SW/4, a total of 40 acres.
