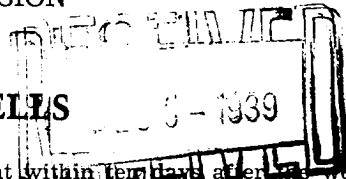

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with oil and followed with 1000 gallons Dowell "XX" Acid treatment. Flushed with 30 barrels of oil; allowed to set for 35 minutes and started swabbing well. Pulled swab four times and well started flowing. On 1st pull 100 barrels, 2nd pull 100 barrels, 3rd pull 100 barrels, 4th pull 100 barrels. Total 400 barrels of oil. 696 barrels fluid of which 70 barrels was oil. The rest was water.
