Refer to your SG-101 covering your  
C. D. Woolworth #1 in the NE/4 Sec. 26, T. 24 S.,  
R. 36 E. Lea County, New Mexico.

We do not require the 300' of 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe,  
a short conductor is all we require for this since  
you must cement the string on the salt back to the  
surface regardless.

It will be necessary for you to use the  
"Squeeze Job" to cement the gas before you run the  
7" pipe; and then use sufficient cement with the  
7" to cement back to the base of the salt plus 100  
sacks.

I am returning the SG-101s for corrections  
and please give the size of hole each string of pipe  
will be set in; also state whether the pipe dimensions  
are ID or OD. I am enclosing a set of regulations  
which covers wells drilled in this area.
