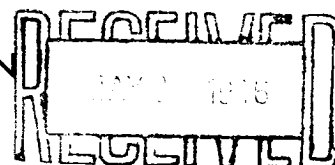

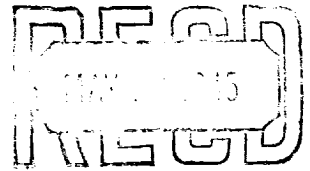

Ran Gamma Ray Survey, bailed hole dry, perforated 7" casing, 30 holes 3255-85', slight show of oil. Acidized 500 gallons, rainbow show of oil. Set retainer 3250'. Pumped 130 sx. cement with 3 sx. Aquagel in formation, last 6 sx. 1475# pressure. Pulled tubing, bailed hole dry, perforated 7" casing with 43 holes 3205-47', no show. Acidized 1500 gallons in 2 stages, no show oil or gas. Shut down after reconditioning, effective April 17, 1945.
