Gentlemen:

We hereby make application on behalf of Sidney Lanier, Box 3284, Midland, Texas for an exception to NFO R-553 on the above captioned well.

In support of this application we state as follows:

1. The Woolworth #1 was originally drilled and completed by Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc. and temporarily abandoned in April, 1957. The well was re-entered and completed as an oil well in the Jalmat Pool March 12, 1962.
2. Plans are currently being made to commence construction of a line to make connection with El Paso Natural Gas Company's line approximately 1/2 mile east.
3. A Gas Sales Contract is being negotiated by Sidney Lanier and El Paso Natural Gas Company.
4. The Oil Conservation Commission will be immediately notified by the filing of a Form C-110 when the gas connection has been made.
5. The well is currently pumping top allowable with a gas-oil ratio of 3088 cubic feet per barrel.
