Water injection into the Jalmat zone of this well was authorized by NMOCC Order No. R-4020.

To convert this well to water injection service, the following operations have been performed:

1. Pulled tubing.
2. Cleaned out with sand pump to 3193'.
3. Ran 93 joints cement lined tubing and Baker Model AD tension packer. Set packer at 2873' in 5½' casing with 14,000# tension (5½' casing is set at 2981').
4. Placed inhibited fresh water above tension packer in casing annulus.
5. Shut in well awaiting completion of injection facilities.

Above work completed 6-30-71.

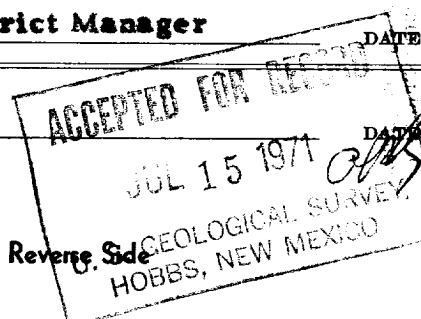

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
