That MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the state of Texas and having a permit to do business in the state of New Mexico, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) to it cash in hand paid by OLSEN-BLOUNT OIL CO., receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, and subject to the exceptions and reservations hereinafter stated, has GRANTED, SOLD, CONVEYED, TRANSFERRED, AND ASSIGNED, and by these presents does hereby GRANT, SELL, CONVEY, TRANSFER, AND ASSIGN, unto the said OLSEN-BLOUNT OIL CO. an undivided 7/8ths interest in and to that certain oil, gas, and mineral lease dated May 26, 1928, executed by C. B. Woolworth, a single man, as lessor, to W. L. Stevens, as lessee, recorded in Book 11, page 517, of the Oil and Gas Records of Lea County, New Mexico, in so far and only in so far as said lease covers and applies to the gas rights in the presently producing gas horizon found between the depths of 2700 feet and 2875 feet below the surface of the ground in the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, containing 80 acres, more or less, and hereby excepting from this conveyance and assignment and reserving unto the assignor all other rights and estates created by said lease.

There is excepted from this assignment and conveyance and reserved unto MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY, its successors and assigns, a free overriding royalty of 1/8th of 7/8ths of 7/8ths of all gas that may be produced, saved, and sold from the premises hereby assigned under and by virtue of the lease above described or any modifications, renewals, or extensions thereof, the same to be received by MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY,

its successors and assigns, as a free, perpetual, overriding royalty without cost or expense of production.

Said overriding royalty herein reserved shall be measured on the basis of the market value thereof at the well.

Fuel gas for operating the premises shall be deducted before computing said overriding royalty.

In so far as the overriding royalty interest herein reserved is concerned, MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY hereby agrees that the assignee, its successors and assigns, may consolidate the leasehold estate hereby assigned with a similar area in the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, in order to form a 160-acre unit for the production of gas, and in the event of such consolidation, MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY'S proportion of the gas production from the consolidated unit by virtue of its ownership of said overriding royalty shall be $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{8}$ th of $\frac{7}{8}$ ths of $\frac{7}{8}$ ths of all gas produced from the consolidated unit.

This assignment is made without warranty of title, expressed or implied.

COMMUNIZATION AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, the undersigned are the owners of mineral interests under various divided and undivided tracts making up the Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and have either executed oil and gas leases upon a portion of said quarter section or have purchased mineral interests therein subject to the terms of oil and gas leases executed thereon or are participating in production from mineral interests owned but not covered by leases; and,

WHEREAS, the leasehold estates created by said oil and gas leases are now owned by Magnolia Petroleum Company, Olsen-Blount Oil Co., Olsen-Blount Drilling Co., and W. L. Goldston; and,

WHEREAS, in order to obtain full production from a gas well located upon a portion of the quarter section above described it has become desirable for the lessees, the owners of the working interest, to pool the working interest of several tracts into the one unit as above described in so far as the same covers the gas production found between the depths of 2700 feet and 2875 feet below the surface of the ground under said lease or leases, all subject to the execution of a communization agreement by the mineral owners;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of one dollar to each of them in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for the purpose of communizing and pooling the North half of said Southeast quarter (N/2 SE/4) of the section above described with the South half of said Southeast quarter (S/2 SE/4) of the section above described into the one unit above described, and for the purpose of clarifying and fixing their royalty payments to be made from the communized or pooled unit, aforesaid, the undersigned hereby stipulate and agree with and for the benefit of Magnolia Petroleum Company, Olsen-Blount Oil Co., Olsen-Blount Drilling Co. and W. L. Goldston, their heirs, successors and assigns that the following described land, situated in Lea County, State of New Mexico, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Section 26,
Township 24 South, Range 36 East N.M.P.M.,

may be operated and produced, in so far as the gas formation found between the depths of 2700 feet and 2875 feet below the surface of the ground as a single community oil and gas leasehold estate, and that rents, royalties and overriding royalties reserved, retained, purchased or held may be paid to the undersigned in the proportions which the mineral ownership or overriding royalty ownership of each of the undersigned bears to the entire mineral ownership under said quarter section.

It is further stipulated and agreed that production obtained from any portion of the above described unitized or communized tract shall be treated as production from the entire quarter section in the same manner as if the undersigned, and each of them, owned undivided mineral interests under the said entire quarter section.

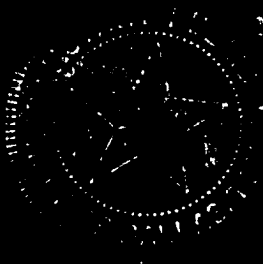

GAS POOLING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, under the terms of a presently valid and subsisting oil and gas lease, a well for oil and gas production has heretofore been drilled in

The South One-half of the Southeast Quarter (S/2 SE/4) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico,

which well has been completed with the production of gas from a gas formation found between the depths of 2700 feet and 2875 feet below the surface of the ground; and,

WHEREAS, the minerals were separately owned and separately leased under the hereinafter described tracts of land, to-wit:

Tract 1: The South One-half of the Southeast Quarter (S/2 SE/4) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico;

Tract 2: The North One-half of the Southeast Quarter (N/2 SE/4) of Section 26, Township 24 South, Range 36 East N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico;

and,

WHEREAS, it appears desirable to all parties hereto to consolidate the two tracts above described for the production of gas from said producing horizon in order to make and form a 160-acre leasehold unit for the allowable gas production;

NOW, THEREFORE, conditioned upon the approval of the royalty owners to be obtained for such consolidation and pooling, the undersigned do hereby agree that the presently valid and subsisting oil and gas mining leases covering the mineral interest in and under the two tracts of land above described, for the purpose only of gas production, and limited to the producing formation found between the depths of 2700 feet and 2875 feet below the surface of the ground, shall hereafter be produced and operated as one consolidated oil and gas leasehold, and the proceeds of the production of gas therefrom, regardless of the location of the well from which such gas is produced, shall be distributed to the parties hereto in the ratio indicated in the following schedule:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>PROPORTION OF GAS PRODUCTION FROM THE CONSOLIDATED UNIT - SE/4, Sec. 26-24S-36E, Lea County, N. M.</u>
Magnolia Petroleum Company - - - - -	1/8 of 7/8 working interest PLUS 49/1024 overriding royalty interest
W. L. Goldston - - - - -	5/24 of 7/8 working interest plus 5/48 of 1/8 royalty interest
Olsen-Blount Oil Co. - - - - -	15/24 of 7/8 working interest
Olsen-Blount Drilling Co. - - - - -	1/24 of 7/8 working interest

The working interests credited above are subject to any overriding royalty interests chargeable to said working interests.

This agreement for pooling, when executed by all of the parties hereto, and the same is approved by the execution of a separate pooling interest of the royalty owners, shall be effective as of the 1st day of September, 1954, and shall control the distribution of proceeds from gas and proceeds from the sale of production

from gas wells sold on and after that date, and shall continue for so long as the oil and gas leases now in full force and effect on said tracts remain valid and subsisting.

No party hereto makes any representation as to the ownership of minerals of any other party to this gas pooling agreement.

Except as herein expressly modified, each of the lease agreements now in force and effect and covering the tracts above described shall govern the rights of the parties.

This agreement has been prepared in multiple copies and the execution by any of the parties hereto on any counter-part shall effectively bind that party.
