

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Plug off present perforations 3215 to 3240' by setting bridging plug at approximately 3200', and cap with 20' of cement. Reperforate casing with four shots per foot from 3045 to 3065' and test for gas production. If an insufficient volume of sweet fuel gas or excessive salt water is encountered at this depth plug back these perforations, unless oil in paying quantities is found. (a) Do not run a plug if a small volume of gas, with or without oil, but without water is encountered. (b) Do not run a plug if production of any nature is not encountered. Re-perforate the casing from 3005' to 3030' with four shots per foot. If an insufficient volume of sweet fuel gas, or excessive salt water is produced from the latter perforations then plug and abandon the well unless oil in paying quantities is found.
