DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3325 Line. Treated pay formation thru perforations in 7" casing from 3321' to 3324' with 1000 gallons Dowell "X".

Before treating, well was making no oil, some water. After treating well flowed 24 bbls. oil, 216 bbls. water in 24 hours thru 2" choke on 2-1/2" tubing. Gas measured 9,609,000 cu. ft. daily. (6-3-38). June 4th well flowed 6 bbls. oil, 245 bbls. water in 24 hours thru 2" choke on 2-1/2" tubing. Gas measured 9,609,000 cu. ft. daily.
