T.D. 3419. Ran Baker cement retainer set 3345'. Cemented with 75 sacks Starcor cement. Formation took 40 sacks under 1500# pressure. Circulated 35 sacks out. Gun perforated with 28 shots at 2' intervals from 3283 to 3336 and one shot at 3335 and another at 3337. Ran 2½" tubing to 3335. Swabbed down 1400' from surface & blew dry with high pressure gas. Tested 24 hrs. Produced no oil or water with estimated 57,000' gas. Treated with 1000 gallons Dowell "X" thru gun perforations. Flowed 120 bbls oil, estimated 120 bbls water, in 24 hrs thru 25/64" choke. Gas measured 2,600,000'. Flowing natural.
