T. D. 3345. Treated with 1000 gallons Dowell "X" thru gun perforations at 2' intervals from 3282 to 3336 and one shot at 3335 and another at 3337. Production before treatment, no oil or water, gas 57,000' daily. After treatment, flowed 120 bbls. oil, estimated 120 bbls. water, in 24 hrs. thru 25/64" choke. Gas measured 2,600,000'.
