NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in C. D. Woolworth

Well No. 5 in NE of Sec. 27, T. 24S, R. 36E,

N. M. P. M., Jal Oil Field Lea County,

on September 29, 19 34 9 5/8 in. 40 lb. casing was #12000 cemented in Brown lime formation at a depth of 3144 feet on September 25, 19 34

1100 sacks of Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton 2 stage job. The two stage device was set at 1670'. 500 sacks were used in the lower stage and 600 sacks were used in the upper stage.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3144 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
