Killed well, pulled tubing, set retainer 3390' and squeezed off perforations with 200 sx. cement. Perforated 7" casing 3330-50' with no show gas or oil. Ran tubing and acidized with 500 gallons mud acid. Recovered 8 bbls. water with slight show oil and gas. Swabbed 6 hrs., 80 bbls. water; pulled tubing and swabbed 11 hrs., 45 bbls. sulphur water. Ran tubing with cement retainer 3325', squeezed 50 sx. cement. Perforated 7" casing 3330-20' with no show oil or gas. Acidized 500 gallons Dowell mud acid, no recovery. Pulled tubing and ran Gamma Ray Survey. Ran tubing and set cement retainer 3275', squeezed (See reverse side)
