

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing developed a hole at a depth of 63' causing the mud to circulate in the cellar. The drill pipe was pulled and the casing cemented through hole from 63' to surface using 50 sacks of Incon cement. We let the cement set for three days and started up August 5, 1935. The cement job was successful.
