DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing. Perforated with Lane Wells from 3390 to 3435'. Set Lane Wells Casing Packer @ 3454. (91 shots from 3390 to 3435). Swabbed dry. Treated with 1500 Gallons Dowell XX acid. Swabbed and flowed 10 barrels fluid per hour after recovering load, shut in over night to pressure up. Opened on 24/64" choke after pulling swab one time, well flowed 19 barrels of fluid in 11 hours. 10% BS&W.

On August 1, opened well, pulled swab twice, flowed 25 barrels fluid, died. Treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell X acid. Swabbed 245 barrels of fluid from hole and shut in to pressure up. Well would not flow steadily. Ran 4-1" Acme flow valves on 148 joints of 1" tubing set inside 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tubing @ 3423'. First valve @ 1456' off-bottom; 2nd valve 1970' off-bottom; third valve @ 2463' off-bottom; 4th valve 2987' off-bottom.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing. Perforated with Lane Wells with 91 shots from 3390-3435. Swabbed dry. Treated w/ 1500 gallons Dowell XX. Could not get to flow steadily. Would swab and flow at rate of 20 Barrels fluid per day. Re-treated with 2000 gallons Dowell X. Swabbed 245 barrels fluid from hole and shut in to pressure up. Well would not flow steadily. Ran 1" tubing inside $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Tubing bottomed @ 3423'. Acame flow valves on 1" tubing @ 1456'; 1970'; 2463'; and 2967'. Kicked with input gas. Flowed 154 barrels fluid first 20 hours. 62 barrels of this amount oil, balance B&W. Input gas rate 100 Mcft. Well gradually declined. On August 17th., rate of flow with input gas was 59 barrels of fluid daily, 35% Water. Would load with water. Installed O.C.S. Duck unit and James sucker rods, after pulling 1" tubing and Acame flow valves, and perforating with Lane Wells from 3320' to 3390' with 136 shots. Well pumps @ rate of 240 barrels fluid per day, 35% water.
