FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Old Total Depth 3469' Plugged Back Depth 3437'. Gum Perforated from 3374' to 3411' with 71 Shots.

Preparing to abandon well and recover as much of 7", 9 5/8" and 13" OD Casing that might be recovered with a Casing Pulling Machine. Will Plug back with 15 Sacks Cement from 3437' to 3347' and shoot pipe loose and recover as much 7" Casing as possible. Fill Hole with mud and place cement Plug at 1402' using 10 Sx Cement and shoot 9 5/8" Casing loose and recover as much casing as possible. Fill hole with mud and will cement 4" Marker extending 8' above the surface with 10 Sacks Cement.
