DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged 7" Casing from 3150' to 3100' with 10 Sacks Cement. Shot Off 7" Casing at 1800' and recovered 64 Jts Total of 1862'. Plugged 9 5/8" Casing with 15 Sacks Cement from 1390' to 1352' and shot 9 5/8" Casing off at 130' and recovered 5 Jts 127', leaving all of the 12 1/2" Surface Pipe in Hole which was 198'. Then Filled Hole with Mud, placing a 10 Sack Cement Cap on Top of Mud in Hole with a piece of 4" Pipe 5' High as a marker in center of cement cap.
