## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Everett well No. 3 was drilled to a total depth of 3508'. This well was completed in April, 1935. It was temporary abandoned in October, 1951 since production was 100% water.

The well was plugged and abandoned in March, 1952, with the approval of the Oil Conservation Commission. The hole was loaded with mud; 25 sacks of cement was run to plug off open hole and top of cement was found at 3450'; recemented with 50 sacks of cement and top of cement was found at 3330' which was satisfactory since casing was set at 3405'. The 7" casing was shot off at 2840' and pulled. Fifty sacks of cement was spotted from 2850' to 2810' and 25 sacks of cement was spotted from 60' to the surface. A 4" marker 4' in height was installed to mark the plugged and abandoned location. 9 5/8" and 12 1/2" casing were left in the hole.
