FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

On October 24, 1957, Everett No. 4 was plugged back to 3385' to shut off excessive water. After plugging back, the well would not make fluid and was acidized with 10,000 gallons 15% HCL. After the acid treatment, the well made 1 BO, 21 BW in 24 hours. This is non-commercial.

It is proposed to squeeze off the zone from 3360' to 3385' and then perforate 3324' to 3340' for oil and test. If this zone produces oil in commercial quantities it will produce as an oil well. If no production is secured, the perforations will be squeezed. If this zone produces gas, it is proposed to perforate additional zones 3264'-3286', 3292-3306', 3312-3324' and the well completed as a gas well.

This well is currently producing from the Yates and Seven Rivers formation at a daily rate of 14 BO, 93 BW, 9 MCF gas with a GOR of 643. The present daily allowable is 14 BOPD. There has been considerable rod and pump trouble which can be attributed to water. It is proposed to plug back to 3385' and test the zone from 3385' to 3364'. It is believed that water production will be decreased and oil production increased as well as reducing cost of operation.
